Enjoy the summer outdoors while cruisin' old U.S. Route 66 on a bicycle! The ride will depart from Buehler Park at 9AM. Enjoy the (9.6 miles) ride to the Little Piney River in Newburg, Missouri. After a rest stop and some entertainment, pedal back (8.9 miles) to Buehler Park. (Sag wagon available to transport those who don't want to attempt the hill on Route T up to Doolittle.)

- Registration 8AM - 9AM at Buehler Park.
- Ride begins promptly at 9AM.

Registration will include chance to win a Bicycle. Two bikes have been donated by Wal-Mart Distribution Center. One chance per registration form.

This trip begins and ends at Buehler Park. Registration form, liability release and ride fee required. No pre-registration, register at the event. Except for sag help up the hill from Newburg to Doolittle, you must be able to ride the loop, Rolla to Newburg and back.
